*This morning Pastor Haug continues his summer sermon series based on the Book of Acts. Often the movement of the Way was led by the Holy Spirit, but in scripture we are reminded that growth of the church was also the result of believers fleeing persecution. The first followers of the Way to be known as Christians were those living in the Greco-Roman city of Antioch. To this day, it is known as “the cradle of Christianity.”*

### *Acts 11:19-30*

#### **Lesson**

<sup>19</sup>Now those who were scattered because of the persecution that took place over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch, and they spoke the word to no one except Jews. <sup>20</sup>But among them were some men of Cyprus and Cyrene who, on coming to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists also, proclaiming the Lord Jesus. <sup>21</sup>The hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number became believers and turned to the Lord. <sup>22</sup>News of this came to the ears of the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. <sup>23</sup>When he came and saw the grace of God, he rejoiced, and he exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast devotion; <sup>24</sup>for he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were brought to the Lord. <sup>25</sup>Then Barnabas went to Tarsus to look for Saul, <sup>26</sup>and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for an entire year they met with the church and taught a great many people, and it was in Antioch that the disciples were first called "Christians."




***PAINT-A-THON - AUGUST 11, 2018***
