



September 2020 In-Person Worship Protocol

1. We ask members who are experiencing possible Covid-19 symptoms to worship with us online.
2. Registration is required for in-person worship, so that we can manage occupancy limits.
 - An invitation will be sent on Mondays by 9:00am. Members may register by following prompts in the email message.
 - Those without online access may call (612) 377-5095 to register, after 9:00am.
 - Worship is capped at 40 worshipers. This number does not include staff and musicians.
 - Registrants will be contacted by phone on Thursday or Friday to confirm.
3. Doors will open for entrance on Sundays at 9:20am.
4. Upon arrival, an usher will:
 - Greet and sign in worshipers on the Church Patio.
 - Confirm worshipers' understanding of September 2020 In-Person Worship Protocol.
 - Direct worshipers to preassigned seats, which are marked by Worship Service Bulletins placed in the pews.
5. Hand sanitizing stations are available in the narthex and office hallway/side entry.
6. All worshipers are required to wear face coverings over nose and mouth throughout the service, except at the altar, when receiving Holy Communion.
7. Holy Communion is celebrated after the livestream has ended. At that time, distribution by individual cups will take place as attendees depart. Anyone who is uncomfortable receiving Holy Communion at this time, is not obliged in any way, to participate.
8. We request that worshipers exit the sanctuary through the side, then cloister doors immediately after Communion is received.
9. Because the virus is primarily spread via aerosols (tiny airborne particles), all hymns will be sung by the music staff and Corona Chorus. Singing is a high-risk activity that worshipers must refrain from at this time.
10. Offerings will be received in baskets in the narthex or office hallway as worshipers enter or exit.
11. Restrooms are available to all participants.
12. Areas beyond the narthex, sanctuary, side entry, and restrooms are not available for use at this time.
13. Please honor social distancing practices and remain 6 feet apart from others. Thank you.
