

This morning Pastor Haug continues his summer sermon series on The Lessons and the Legends of the Apostles. Traditionally, this would focus on Jesus' twelve disciples and the traditions attributed to them, but it also includes the last prophet of the Old Testament, St. John the Baptist. Surprisingly, John the Baptist is included in the 12 apostles standing above St. Peter's Square in Rome. John the Baptist is a unique figure in Christian memory, a hinge between the Old Testament prophets and the first Christians. In today's gospel we hear the story of John's own mysterious birth ending with the startling question, "What then shall this child become?" The feast day for John the Baptist is traditionally celebrated on June 24th.

John 3:22-30




The Lessons and Legends of the Apostles – St. John the Baptist

²² After this Jesus and his disciples went into the Judean countryside, and he remained there with them and was baptizing. ²³ John also was baptizing at Aenon near Salim, because water was plentiful there, and people were coming and being baptized ²⁴ (for John had not yet been put in prison).

²⁵ Now a discussion arose between some of John's disciples and a Jew over purification. ²⁶ And they came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, he who was with you across the Jordan, to whom you bore witness—look, he is baptizing, and all are going to him." ²⁷ John answered, "A person cannot receive even one thing unless it is given him from heaven. ²⁸ You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, 'I am not the Christ, but I have been sent before him.' ²⁹ The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete. ³⁰ He must increase, but I must d;ecrease."
