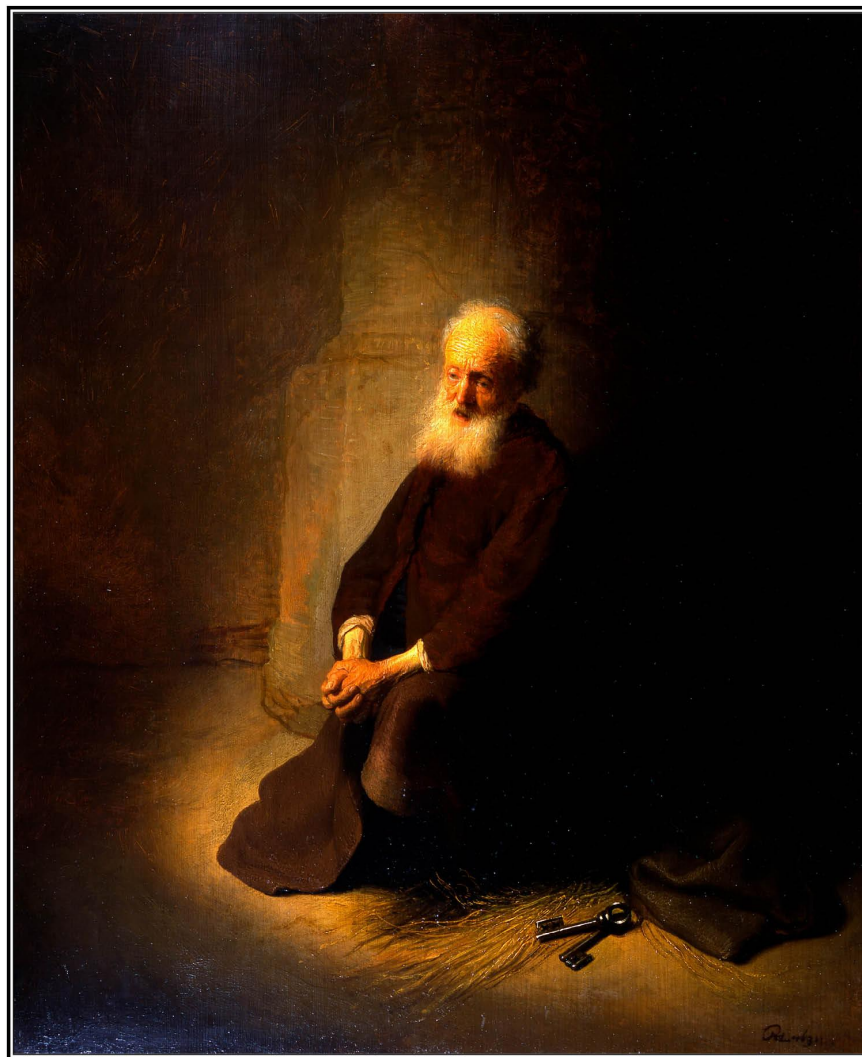

January 18th traditionally commemorates Peter being led by God's grace to acknowledge Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of the living God. This confession is the common confession that unites us with Peter and with all Christians of every time and place. June 29th is traditionally marked as the commemoration date for the martyrdoms of St. Peter and St. Paul in Rome.

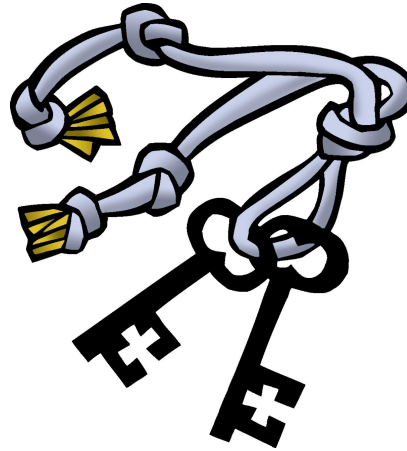
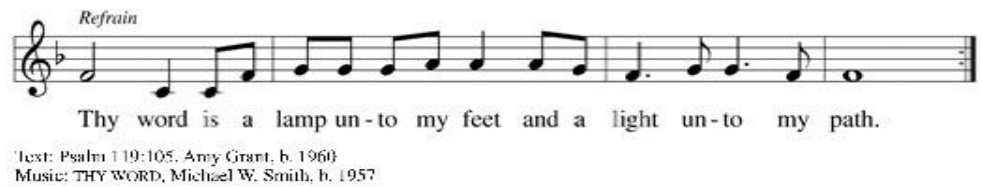

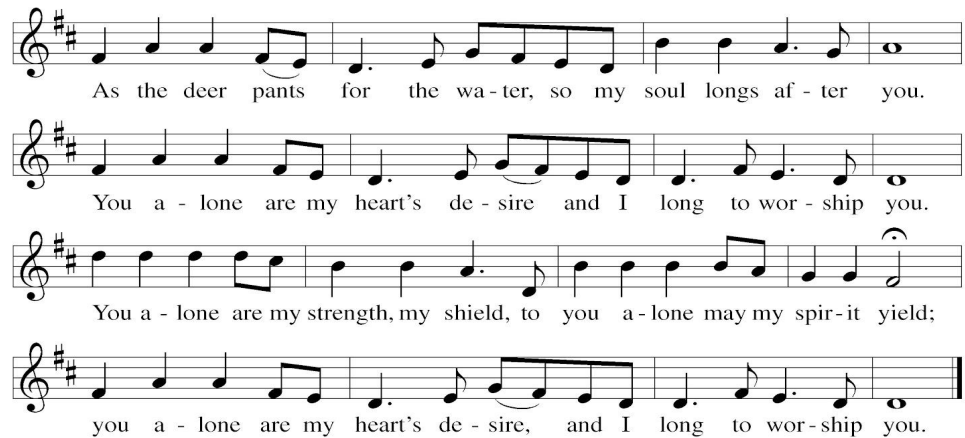
